Registration starts at 8:30 AM and will close at 11:30 AM. It will be held at the top of Bear Bottom Lodge in the VIP room.

Entry deadline is 12:00 noon the Saturday before the race. Entries may be emailed to barbaraboucher@charter.net, mailed to: SSRT, P.O. Box 1384, Big Bear Lake, CA 92315, or done in person at Alpine Sports Center, 41530 Big Bear Boulevard, Big Bear Lake. **Nastar racers may sign up on the day of the event.**

Entry fee is \$20 per race for junior racers and masters racers. An entry for the whole race series is \$100.

Bib deposit is \$20 cash, which will be returned at the end of the second run when the bib is returned.

Classes: Racers will be divided by male/female, novice/USSA, and by age class. Junior racers will be divided into 6 different age classes. Birth years 2000-2002 are J-6, 1997-1999 are J-5, 1995-1996 are J-4, 1993-1994 are J-3, 1991-1992 are J-2, and 1988-1990 are J-1. Masters age classes will initially be divided by ages 20-44 and 45 up.

Awards all junior racers will receive awards after each race at the Awards Ceremony. The ceremony will be located at the Taco Bar at the top of the stairs by the VIP room (near chair 2).

- Junior Racers placing 1st through 3rd will receive a medal, 4th through 10th will receive a ribbon, and participant ribbons will be awarded to all others. Masters will receive a t-shirt for 1st through 3rd place.
- Novice juniors need only complete one run with no disqualifications to place. USSA members and masters must finish both runs to place.
- Junior racers who start at least 3 races will receive a trophy at the end of the season. Masters race series winners 1st through 3rd place will receive a golf/polo shirt at the end of the season.
- NASTAR racers will receive Gold, Silver or Bronze Medals depending on handicaps.
